

Major Happenings



The LEGO Group hired approximately 500 people for its \$1 billion carbon neutral manufacturing facility in Chesterfield County. The company expects to create more than 1,760 jobs over the next 10 years.

Sapporo recently acquired Stone Brewing and invested \$40 million to double production capacity in the City of Richmond, adding nearly 80 new jobs.



Greater Richmond is home to 8 Fortune 500 headquartered companies and 4 additional firms that top the Fortune 1000.

Condair Group AG will invest \$57.2 million in a production facility in Chesterfield County. The 400,000-sq.-ft. location is slated to begin operations in 2025. The project will create 180 new jobs.

Plenty Unlimited, a Californiabased company, broke ground on its \$300 million indoor vertical farming campus, to be the world's largest upon completion. The company, operating in Chesterfield County, will add 300 full-time jobs upon completing the facility over the next six years.

Topsoe, a Danish manufacturer and international leader in carbon emission reduction technologies, plans to invest more than \$400 million to build a factory in Chesterfield County. The project is expected to create 150 new jobs.



Tucker Door & Trim will invest \$10 million to establish a new manufacturing and assembly operation for fiberboard and fiberglass doors and windows in Henrico County, adding 50 new jobs.



Performance Food Group began operations at its newly completed 332,000 sq.ft. sales and distribution center in Hanover County. The food distribution giant will add nearly 125 new jobs over the next few years.

SanMar Corporation established its largest distribution center in Hanover County. The apparel and accessories wholesaler will invest at least \$50 million in the 1.1 million sq.ft. building and will create more than 1,000 new jobs.



Weidmüller Group, leading а electronic component design and manufacturing company, announced it will invest \$16.4 million to expand its Chesterfield County operations. The investment will add more than 100 new jobs.

Coca-Cola Consolidated completed a \$50 million expansion at its manufacturing and warehouse facility in Henrico County. The bottling company added 210,000 sg.ft. and 40 employees.



Amazon celebrated the opening of its 2.7 million sg.ft., state-of-the-art robotics fulfillment center where 1,000 employees will work to assist in fulfilling customer orders.



Cascades, a leader in manufacturing green packaging and hygiene products, announced it completed production of its first roll of 100 percent recycled containerboard in Hanover County. Cascades added 700 jobs for its \$500 million retrofit.



Greater Richmond is full of upcoming new developments and redevelopments to include office and retail space as well as green space for residents. Developments include GreenCity (dubbed Virginia's first Eco-District) as well as the Upper Magnolia Green site, two future data center parks, Springline at District 60, Diamond District plus the Henrico Sports and Event Center.
